The Mahler / Adams Residence, 1924-1998

Creativity has reigned throughout the chain of title of the Mahler/Adams House. Since the early 1950s, it has been home to a sculptress, architect, and a noted fashion designer. The long-time studio and residence of sculptor Anna Mahler (daughter of composer Gustav Mahler) was acquired and artfully renovated by architect Williams Adams in 1998. The result is an inspiring new space for modern Canyon living. The warm, high-ceilinged, wood-beamed live/workspace with fireplace flows seamlessly into a modern kitchen with stainless steel appliances, dining banquette, or the two bedrooms. An oversized hillside sundeck, sheltered by a canopy of shade trees, affords sylvan canyon vistas, making it a serene place to unwind or host friends. The carport, parking pad, and driveway allow for off-street parking for up to 6 cars. The Mahler/Adams Residence offers a unique Canyon Living lifestyle in a one-of-a-kind blend of rich, bohemian history and warm contemporary architectural significance.
